2021 Annual Report

2021 is in the rearview mirror but overall, the year was successful in several ways. Some of the highlights:

- We adopted out 429 cats and 12 dogs, even with many foster parents going back to work and not being able to spend as much time rescuing and fostering cats and dogs.
- We TNR'd 865 feral and Community Cats, an all-time record for our 'small TNR program'.
- We started an Emergency Medical Fund to help foster parents with emergency vetting expenses incurred by their foster pets.
- We held a Calendar Photo Contest where adopters, fosters and supporters were able to submit photos of their pet (HOPE foster pet, HOPE adopted pet or any pet) for inclusion in the HOPE 2022 calendar.
